IsraLimmud is a fellowship program certified by the Jewish Federation of Metropolitan Chicago. Led by former Jerusalem Post Editor Carl Schrag, the fellowship consists of seven to eight workshops, which will equip participants with a strong underpinning of understanding of Israel's history and provide a proper context for engaging in advocacy on behalf of the Jewish state. For a select group of participants, the Fellowship will culminate in an all expenses-paid trip to Washington, D.C. to advocate Illinois legislators on Israel's behalf. IsraLimmud is being offered to Illinois college and graduate students, as well as to recent college graduates, during the 2009-2010 academic year, with workshop schedules tailored to meet participants' busy schedules.
